The artifice of merging elements of different origins by recomposing them into a unicum that leads to cancel the initial specificities and diversities is the goal of this group show.

The exhibition 'Contaminations' is realized by comparing artists with different stylistic paths and codes so that the spectators' senses could be contaminated in their perception.

The works on view act as sensory stimulators each for its specific characteristics. The final contamination will be the result of what is perceived, as singular and univocal, by the viewer, able to autonomously bring the exhibited works back to that exceptional event, precisely unique, that is the art in which the individual contributions are recomposed.

And so the contaminations bring us:

from the immediacy of the pop and playful world of Peppe and Lucio Perone who faithfully transpose their daily lives into their art ...
... to the archetypal, rigorous, eternal works of Antonella Zazzera who, with patiently, weaves her works and seems to weave the time ...
... from the 'silent, indestructible and ephemeral, fragile and doubtful' sculptures by Alex Pinna into we can all identify...
... to Matteo Peretti's pierced dinosaurs that symbolize the end of a myth by which we have to face with when the previous models are missing ...
... from the colorful tanks of Paolo Ceribelli that suggest to the spectator that he has look for a second chance by going beyond the limit ...
... to Alessandro Valeri's neon that with the word 'still' repeated several times seals the bulimia of which we are all victims and through its red color, the primary gas existing in nature, it evokes passions that perhaps should continue to burn feeding us.

Finally in this kaleidoscope of lived experiences and different messages, the viewer can and must allow himself to be contaminated until he recognizes himself and finds his trace, his 'always in never'.
